

For foreign patients who do not hold Japanese public health insurance:

What to Bring In addition to your hospital patient card (only for those who have visited our hospital before), referral letter (medical information document), image data (only for those who have it), and medication notebook (*Okusuri Techo*), please bring the following items:

1. Passport and Residence Card (*Zairyu Card*)
2. Travel insurance or medical insurance (document showing your policy/membership number)
3. Your credit card

Please note that for identity verification and administrative purposes, we will inspect and make a copy of your passport, residence card, travel insurance, etc., when you visit. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

About Medical Expenses For patients who do not hold Japanese nationality and are not enrolled in a valid public health insurance system in Japan, medical fees will be charged at a rate of 30 yen per 1 medical service point (meals will be charged at 2,190 yen per meal).
