

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Revision of Medical Fees for Foreign Patients Without Japanese Public Health Insurance

Effective September 1, 2026, charges for medical services provided to patients who are not Japanese nationals and are not enrolled in a valid public health insurance system in Japan will be revised from 10 yen to 30 yen per point on the medical fee schedule. The charge for meals during hospitalization will also be revised from 730 yen to 2,190 yen per meal.

Our hospital's medical resources are supported by insurance premiums and taxes paid by the people of Japan. We have therefore reviewed our fees so that foreign patients are asked to bear costs equivalent to those borne by Japanese citizens.

2. Revised fees: 30 yen per point on the medical fee schedule; 2,190 yen per meal during hospitalization
